In accordance with Title 27:7-35 et seq., and Regulation of the New Jersey Department of Transportation, you are hereby notified that your firm has been PREQUALIFIED by the New Jersey Department of Transportation. Please see ATTACHMENT A for your firm's assigned financial capability, work classification(s), and work classification limit(s).

Your firm's financial capability is based on $((\text{net working capital or net worth}) \times 15) + ((\text{net book value of construction equipment, less the value of any outstanding loans}) \times 15) + ((\text{unsecured lines of credit in accordance with the Questionnaire less any outstanding loans}) \times 7)$ as determined by the Department from the information your firm submitted for the 12-Months period Close of Business on 12/31/2025. Please see ATTACHMENT B for explanation.

Your firm's financial capability is defined as an amount, calculated pursuant to N.J.A.C. 16:44-3.4, used to determine a contractor's work classification limit. Work classification limit is defined as the maximum dollar amount that a contractor may bid on any advertised project for a particular work classification.

This PREQUALIFICATION will be effective on 6/24/2026 and will expire on 6/30/2027

Effective dates shall be 15 days from the Department's receipt of the completed Questionnaire and required fee or 15 days from the Department's receipt of any additional information requested, provided that such additional information is satisfactory to the Department. A contractor's prequalification shall expire 18 months after the full one-year accounting cycle close of business date of the financial statement accompanying the Questionnaire. A contractor's prequalification shall expire nine months after the six-month accounting cycle close of business date of the financial statement accompanying the Questionnaire.

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Bids will only be accepted from a contractor prequalified with the Department pursuant to N.J.A.C. 16:44-3. Bids will only be accepted from a contractor who has been prequalified in at least one of the work classifications required in the project advertisement. Bids will be accepted from a contractor in an amount that does not exceed its work classification limit. When there is a question as to whether a bid is within the contractor's prequalification or, where it reasonably appears that a contractor may not have the prequalification that will allow it to bid on a project for which bids are being sought, the bid will be opened provisionally. If the bid is for a different work classification or in a dollar amount greater than the contractor's maximum work classification limit, the bid will be rejected.

Please be advised that the supplementary provisions (Project specific Specifications) for all present and future Bridge Painting contracts required all contractors and sub-contractors to have valid Certificates SSPC-QP1 and SSPC-QP2 issued by The Society for Protective Coatings (<http://www.sspc.org/>) at the time of bid and duration of the contract.

In order to be continuously eligible to bid on projects to be undertaken by this Department, your firm's next Contractor's Financial and Equipment Statement Questionnaire and Past Performance Record should be submitted one month before the expiration date, but must be received at least 15 days prior to the date set for receipt of bids for which the prequalification will be used.

Requirements of New Jersey Administrative Code 16:44-13.1 and 13.2 must be complied with by all entities prequalified with the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
